Did you know?

As a member of the fund you have certain rights with regards transfers! Your rights include:

- ✓ The employer who wishes to transfer members to another umbrella fund **must first consult with members** on the matter.
- ✓ The employer must provide **a benefit comparison** between the TSRF and the proposed new fund.
- ✓ Where the benefits of the new Fund are less beneficial to members **an employer must achieve a 75% approval rate from members** before they can move members to another fund.
- ✓ Members should be given **30 days to lodge an objection** to the intended transfer.
- ✓ Up and until the **FSCA** has approved the transfer to another Fund, your employer is obliged to continue contributing to the TSRF.

Section 14 transfers are also referred to the Fund for approval. A transfer will only be considered where the transfer is:

- Fair and equitable;
- Members' rights are protected;
- Members' reasonable benefit expectations, in terms of the rules of the Fund, and any additional benefits, are met.
- The Financial Sector Conduct Authority (FSCA previously the FSB) must also approve the transfer before it can be finalised.
